

Burgundy 2022 En Primeur Offer



Finally! After what seems like many years of very difficult vintages for the Burgundians, we have an abundant and very good, if not excellent vintage to really get excited about. This is a vintage that was much needed in Burgundy as the weather in the previous few had been incredibly cruel to so many growers, many losing over half their crop in the preceding vintages due to hail, drought and rain at the wrong times.

Not all escaped the ravages of an ever-changing climate in Burgundy, but the overall picture was one of a return to more normal yields and fabulous quality across the Cote d'Or and Cote Chalonnaise. There were instances of hydric stress in some parts but being brave in the vineyard (which the Burgundians are now well used to) meant fruit was brought in in excellent quality and, for Burgundy, very healthy volumes.

Literally everything on the list comes highly recommended, there is superb quality across all areas and price points. There are fabulous wines to be had from Chablis in the north all the way through the Cote d'Or and into the Chalonnaise for both early drinking and medium to long term cellaring.

Wines are available in good numbers again this year from Benjamin Leroux, Domaine de Montille, Olivier Merlin and Eric Forest. These join some of other favourites with more helpful quantities such as Vincent Latour, Sylvain Dussort and Joseph Pascal.

We are so pleased to be able to introduce new growers to our Burgundy portfolio in the shape of Domaine Felettig, Domaine Sigaut, Georges Joillot and Adrien Defaix; exceptional wines all, but quantities from these growers are very limited.

The stellar wines of Frederic Magnien, in both his guises of Domaine Michel Magnien and Maison Frederic Magnien, are ones to seriously consider stocking up on for some long-term cellaring, they are very special and will reward 5+ years of patience.

Whilst this is decent sized vintage it is still Burgundy so the quantities are limited across all the wines. Some will sell out very quickly and some, due to the huge demand, are on allocation.

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Benjamin Leroux

Having created a name for himself as regisseur of Domaine du Comte Armand, Benjamin Leroux established a small negociant business based in Beaune in 2007. The range is confined to the Cote d'Or, from Chassagne-Montrachet to Gevrey-Chambertin. The possibilities are very exciting for this exceptionally talented vigneron. Benjamin is a master at delivering purity of fruit alongside a seamless texture in his wines which have only the subtlest influence of oak.

Domaine de Montille

Founded in the mid-18th century, this family-owned estate is one of the most historic in the Côte d'Or, with ninthgeneration Etienne de Montille now at its helm. Etienne inherited this responsibility from his late father, Hubert, whose tenure lasted a staggering 50 years. Etienne was an early advocate of organic farming. In 1995 he introduced these principles to the estate's vineyards. Biodynamic practices followed in 2005.

Over the last 20 years Domaine Merlin has become one of the most respected producers in the Mâconnais. Vineyard holdings are just over 20 hectares, 18.5 of which is planted to Chardonnay. 2022 has been a huge success for the Merlins - we have extended our Merlin offer this year to nearly every wine they produce. They are all very, very good but, if we had to pick just 2 they would be Sur la Roche for its depth and richness and the Roche Vineuse for fabulous bang for buck.

Éric Forest

"One of the great vintages of my career, the 2022s have an intensity of fruit with remarkable energy and tension," said a happy Éric Forest. The L'Ame Forest is from four vineyards, averaging 50 years old, on marne and very old limestone soils of decomposed oyster shells on the northern slope of the Vergisson hill. Elevage in 300 litre barrels, 20% new oak. La Roche is a magnificent parcel of south-east facing vines at 401m (the limit for the impending 1er Cru classification is 400m) on hard, compacted Bajocien limestone. According to Eric, they are the most expressive grapes he grows in Vergisson. His Bourgogne Blanc is fabulous value. The Clos des Charmes was showing particularly well at the tasting and is highly recommended

Made from a 0.4ha parcel, Alexandra Pascal is the only person in Puligny producing a red Puligny-Montrachet village. This is showing great fruit, structure and nice rich fruit. Will be drinking upon release.

Samuel Billaud

Billaud's wines are often compared in quality with the great Chablis of Domaine Raveneau. Samuel's 2022s are exceptional, combining rich fruit flavours, generous textures and perfectly poised minerality. Extended ageing on fine lees for 9 to 18 months in a combo of demi-muids and stainless. The Village Chablis is superb value and shows why Chablis remains one of the great white wines of the world.

Domaine Vincent Latour

Vincent vinifies in a mix of traditional 228 It barrels, demi-muids and foudres making for wonderfully traditional white Burgundies with superb structure, richness, and harmony across the range. The Chassagne Morgeot and 1er Cru Meursaults are special and will need at least a couple of years, preferably more, to show their true potential.

The Meursault Cuvée St Jean is excellent; *"Ripe-fruited like the St-Aubin Cuvée Thomas, creamy lemon generosity balanced by a touch of spice and light oak impression."* 17/10 Jancis Robinson

Another pick is the Meursault Grands Charrons; "Complex and inviting aroma that has both bright citrus fruit and lovely leesy richness. Domaine Collet

The Collet family own 40 hectares of exceptional Chablis vineyards which they farm mainly organically, and the rest is in organic conversion. Romain Collet represents the new generation in charge of the Domaine. He took the reins in 2009, pioneering fermentations with ambient yeasts in 2010. Collet harvests relatively ripe grapes and conducts fermentation and élevage in a variety of vessels, including stainless steel, concrete eggs and oak in formats ranging between old foudres and new barrels—the latter exclusively from Tonnellerie Cavin.

Adrien Defaix

Adrien Defaix is the nephew of Didier Defaix (Domaine Bernard Defaix). Their wines are made at the domaine in tandem and are identical in every way. Domaine Bernard Defaix was founded in 1959, with just two hectares and now extends to some 27 hectares in and around the village of Milly. Everything is farmed in a sustainable, ecological, organic fashion, with elements of biodynamic viticulture increasingly incorporated. The Léchet and Léchet Reserve are absolutely superb wines - get them while you can!

Vincent Girardin

Eric Germain was extremely pleased with the 2022s, "The whites are of very high quality, the reds have a great density, but also great purity. The watch-word with Girardin's 2022s is generosity - pure fruit flavours are to the fore with acidity and tannins remaining fresh and focussed and lending just the right structure and balance to these lovely wines. The Corton Perrieres is awesome. The Chassagne Morgeot is special; described by Neal Martin as "... delivering real weight and concentration towards the (dare I say it) Leflaive-like finish. Superb."

Domaine Michel Niellon

On average Niellon was 30% down on last year so quantities are limited but the resulting wines are excellent. The village Chassagne comes from 15 parcels totalling under 2ha and sees 70% oak ferment. Niellon has less that 1ha of Maltroie which sees 80% oak ferment, 20% of which is new.

Domaine Paul & Marie Jacqueson

Founded by Henri Jacqueson in 1947, succeeded by his son Paul in 1972 and joined by Paul's daughter Marie in 2006, and more recently by his son Pierre, this domaine has long been recognised as one of the very best in the Côte Chalonnaise and its wines adorn the lists of many of the finest restaurants in France. They have 13 hectares of wonderfully sited vines, many of which are very old, and prune hard to reduce yields to around 35 hl/ha. They only work the vineyards manually, with very minimal vine treatments. They are one of very few producers in the village (together with Dureuil Janthial) to hand-pick everything. Extremely proficient winemaking and judicious use of new oak (20% for whites and 25% for reds) make for beautifully crafted, ripe, intense, sensual wines which have the class to belie their origins.

Domaine Georges Joillot

So impressed with the gorgeous silky textures, freshness and sheer class of these wines. This traditional 14 hectare family domaine, founded in 1929 and situated adjacent to Château de Pommard, had a new lease of life breathed into it in 2019 when the young generation took over its running. Today at the helm are Jeanne Joillot (great grand-daughter of the founder, Robert Joillot), her step-brother, Simon Goutard and Jeanne's husband, Gregoire Guidot. The property was re-named in 2019 in honour of Jeanne's grandfather, Georges. There are no secrets here. Fastidious attention in the vines, with grass cover and labourage, harvesting at a balanced level of ripeness in small, perforated crates and strict sorting of the grapes, which are then 100% destemmed. Vinification is traditional, in open-topped fermenters, for 10-20 days and there is particular emphasis on measured extraction - particularly in Pommard - to ensure that the finished wines are seamless, graceful and accessible. They use 20% to 30% new oak barrels for between 10 and 14 months. Their wines are bottled without filtration.

Domaine Joseph Colin

"In 30 years, I have never tasted a vintage which has tasted so well from barrel, energy, precision and fruit! The fruit was of exceptional quality. The balance between acidity, alcohol levels and phenolic maturity was simply perfect! The juices were fermented in barrels mainly in 500 and 600L containers supplemented with traditional 228L Burgundian barrels (for an average of around 10% new barrels). The wines are aged for 12 months in barrels then racked and assembled for 4 months in vats. The wines were bottled this December unfiltered. To conclude, we are delighted with this magnificent 2022 vintage which will remain a benchmark for the estate." - Joseph Colin. Couldn't agree more!

Domaine Fernand & Laurent Pillot

Laurent strongly believes in low yields and a strict form of viticulture, which he describes as being "80% organic". Any necessary treatments are kept to the very minimum possible. All his white wines are vinified in barrique and are characterized by purity, accessibility, fresh fruit flavours and minerality, rather than oak. His finest white is from 1er Cru Vide Bourse, 40+ year old vines (directly next to Bâtard Montrachet) and is chiselled, tense and salty. His reds, which are generally 100% destemmed, have improved beyond all recognition over the last few vintages. They are ripe, succulent, elegant and delicious.

Domaine Anne & Herve Sigaut

Although Anne and Hervé took over the 7-hectare property in 1990, it is only in very recent years that the domaine has undergone a total transformation. Lately, the wines have been amongst the finest in the village as a series of brilliant reviews has attested. They have always had wonderfully sited old vines, but they now work organically from flowering onwards and yields have been significantly reduced. They follow the lunar calendar and, in some of their vineyards, plough by horse. With minimal intervention in the winery, a judicious usage of new oak and only one racking prior to bottling without fining or filtration, the Sigauts are quietly making some of the most well-defined, thoroughbred wines in Chambolle.

Maison Frédéric Magnien

As well as running the family estate (Domaine Michel Magnien), Frédéric buys grapes from many of the best growers in Morey and the surrounding villages which he vinifies in a separate cellar adjacent to the domaine. The majority of the farmers who supply grapes work organically or biodynamically but not all, so most of these wines are not labelled as such. The vinification is carried out with the same methods and with the same care and attention as the domaine's wines and the results are equally impressive. No new oak used. All of Frederic's wines are aged in a combination of terracotta amphorae and old oak (sourced from DRC).

Domaine Michel Magnien

Frédéric Magnien is the fifth generation to run the family estate. Since he took over in 1996, he has expanded the domaine from 4 to 18 hectares with the whole estate being farmed biodynamically since 2010. Frédéric continues to develop the range of vessels that he uses for ageing the wines and this year has added new 225 litre clay jars to his existing stock of 228 litre oak barrels, smaller 160 litre clay jars and larger 350 litre terracotta amphorae made by TAVA in Italy. His aim is to have approximately half of each wine aged in barrel and half in the more neutral clay vessels.

Domaine Christian Bellang

A family estate for several generations, the Meursault estates' family tree goes back to 1789. In 1974 Christian took over his parents' estate, with vines mainly in Meursault, and some of his father-in-law's vines in Savigny-lès-Beaune, his son Christophe, joining him in 1995. Together they expanded the estate with plots in Meursault, Savigny-lès-Beaune, Chorey-lès-Beaune and Beaune. Today Christophe manages the estate, now totalling 9 hectares.

Domaine Billard Père et Fils

Domaine Billard has approximately 12.5 hectares of vineyards in different appellations throughout the Côtes de Beaune. Their largest holdings are in the Hautes-Côtes de Beaune with other small plots located in Saint-Romain, Saint-Aubin 1er Cru, Auxey-Duresses and Beaune. The domaine passed from father to son recently and Jérôme Billard has brought a new philosophy to his family domaine. Farming is done with respect for nature and follows the principles of organic farming. Yields are kept low through the use of cover crops and severe pruning and all the vines are harvested by hand. Only indigenous yeasts are used for the fermentation.

Domaine Réné Cacheux

Domaine René Cacheux is tiny - just 3.26 hectares - but they have some of the most enviable vineyards in the heart of the village of Vosne-Romanée. Here, old vines are tended with the utmost care, producing some very pure expressions of this acclaimed terroir. The adventure of this small family farm nestled in the heart of the village of Vosne-Romanée, rich in know-how for 4 generations, continues with the latest generation, Gérald, after an experience of 18 years acquired in various wineries in the region, having taken over in 2004. Gerald's wines offer remarkable value when compared with other producer's Vosnes. The wines do require some cellaring but will repay patience.

Domaine Sylvain Dussort

Sylvain Dussort comes from a long line of winemakers and coopers based in Meursault. He took over the estate in 1982 with his wife and over the years has expanded the estate with the acquisition of new vineyards as well as the modernisation and enlargement of the winery buildings. The estate now totals 6.5 hectares, half of which is Bourgogne Blanc, the wine that Sylvain takes the most pride in. We loved Sylvain's Meursaults '22 - they are layered and textural and will cellar brilliantly.

Domaine Gaëlle et Jérôme Meunier

Based in the village of Barizey, 5 miles from Mercurey, they have 10ha worked with minimal intervention, low yields and little chaptalisation. It is all hand-harvested and sorted, the fruit being the focus with gentle oak, not only the result of the excellent terroir, but also of quality-focused appellation laws. The maximum yield here is closer to the stringent regulations of the Cote d'Or than to the slightly more relaxed rules that apply to the rest of the Chalonnaise. The whole range offers amazing value. The Puligny is wonderful, all crisp cooking apple and pastry.

Gilles Remoriquet is not a winemaker who rests on his laurels. He is forever looking for ways to improve his wines. Most recently he has been to the Jura to see a specialist about selecting the right blend of manure and has bought a second sorting table which eliminates under-ripe berries by flotation! Cuvaisons are long, giving a light colour yet concentrated, intense fruit flavours. Remoriquet is one of the top estates in Nuits but the prices have yet to catch up. The Remoriquet domaine dates back to the end of the 19th century and the property is now managed by 4th-generation Gilles Remoriquet, oenology graduate of the acclaimed University of Dijon. We're very much at home in 'traditional' Burgundy here - Gilles strongly believes in horse-ploughing, limiting yields, hand-harvesting and barrel maturation. But he's also an extensive traveller, visiting vinous colleagues around France to see what others are doing with regards to soil quality and the like.
